This year's concert, led by saxophonist, composer, and bandleader **Paul Winter**, is called "**Bring Home the Sun.**" Performances take place **on Thursday, December 19 at 8:00 PM; Friday, December 20 at 8:00 PM; and Saturday, December 21 at 2:00 PM and 7:30 PM, at The Cathedral of St. John the Divine located at 1047 Amsterdam Avenue at 112<sup>th</sup> Street, Manhattan.**

Presented in the capacious space of the Cathedral, the concert brings people together during the longest night of the year to celebrate the turning point in the Earth's journey around the sun, and the birth of a new year. This year's Solstice, focused on the sunny and rhythmic music of Brazil, promises to be a landmark in its long tradition of interweaving diverse performers of the world. The **Paul Winter Consort** will be joined by legendary Brazilian singer **Ivan Lins**; Brazilian guitarist and vocalist **Renato Braz**; a Brazilian chorus; the dancers and drummers of the **Forces of Nature Dance Theatre**; and dynamic gospel vocalist **Theresa Thomason**.
