PART-TIME

FRONT OFFICE ASSISTANT/RECEPTIONIST

Part Time (Monday – Friday; Year Round)

The Office Assistant will be repsonsible for providing administrative support to ensure that office servicese are delivered in an efficient manner. The Receptionist has a comprehensize understanding othe program's activities and, as the first point of contact, is responsible for maintaining student records and ensuring that inquiries and questions are answered and directed appropriately, while maintaining a positive, welcoming, and caring environment in the front office. They must be comfortable with Microsoft Office programs as well as able to learn how to use unique registration software.

AFTER SCHOOL GROUP LEADER

Part Time (Monday – Friday; September – June)

Group Leaders must be over 18 years old. They lead and organize activities for the students in their group, work cooperatively with program specialists and develop team spirit among group members. Experience with children preferred, but training is provided.

FULL-TIME (SEASONAL)

SUMMER CAMP PRESCHOOL HEAD TEACHER

(Monday - Friday; June - August)

The Summer Camp Head Teacher leads and organizes activities for their group of children under 4.9 years old. They must support campers' cognitive, emotional, social, and physical needs while keeping parents informed. The Candidate must have a BA in Education and/or NYS Early Childhood License or equivalent. They must have 2 years of group teaching experience with children under 6 years old and excellent communication skills.



SUMMER CAMP PRESCHOOL ASSISTANT TEACHER

(Monday – Friday; June – August)

The Summer Camp Assistant Teacher works with the Head Teacher to lead creative activities, establish a routine, and support the social-emotional needs of children under 4.9 years old. Experience working with young children is greatly preferred.

SUMMER CAMP SPECIALIST

(Monday – Friday; June – August)

Specialists lead 45-minute periods in their area of expertise with all camp groups, ranging from ages 3.7 to 14. They must create lesson plans, engage campers, and help them build skills. Available areas: Arts and Crafts, Sports and Games, Nature, Performing Arts

SUMMER CAMP GROUP LEADER

(Monday – Friday; June – August)

Group Leaders must be over 18 years old. They lead and organize activities for the campers in their group, work cooperatively with program specialists and develop team spirit among group members. Experience with children preferred, but training is provided.

SUMMER CAMP LEADER-IN-TRAINING

(Monday – Friday; June – August)

Leaders In Training are High School students aged 16 and 17 who can participate in an internship program that can make a positive difference in the lives of the campers. They will support Group Leaders and learn the ins and outs of group management. They will be paid a weekly stipend.
