Guiding Principles for The Code of Conduct

- To uphold the ACT Mission and Values
- To ensure that the rights of all individuals are protected while attending the camp
- To establish the safest and best possible learning environment for all camp participants
- To ensure that breaches are treated in a fair and consistent manner

Expectations

- All parents and children are to treat one another, staff and property with respect
- All parents and children are to act in a way which does not endanger, intimidate or interfere with the participation of others
- Children have the responsibility to follow the instructions given by camp staff for their safety and the wellbeing of themselves and others
- All parents and children have the responsibility to behave according to this code of conduct
- Children are to wear their face mask as instructed by CDC at all time and follow social distancing guidelines.
- Use of cell phones are not permitted to be used by children during program hours. Cell phones are to be off and stored in their bag.

Unacceptable Behavior

These behaviors are considered unacceptable and could result in the suspension or dismissal of camper(s):

- Using language which is offensive, sexist or racist
- Fighting, bullying or any other forms of aggressive behavior
- Leaving the boundaries of the group or facilities without permission
- Behaving in a manner which is potentially dangerous to self and others
- Behaving in a manner which damages or vandalizes the property of others or The Cathedral

Any breach of the Rules or the Code of Conduct will initiate a disciplinary action. ACT Program reserves the right to suspend or dismiss a camper's participation in camp activities, without refund of camp tuition, if such disciplinary action is required. Before such a decision is fully made, the camper and parent/guardian will meet with camp director and coordinators to determine the best course of action.
