OUR CORE PROGRAM

Our philosophy stems from our eight core values (*fun, child centered, learning, organization, diversity, teamwork, safety and communication*) and frames the behavior we exhibit with children, with staff and through program activities.

Children have a voice and we listen.

A *child-centered* approach dictates that we listen and offer options that enhance a child's sense of self and social development. *Diverse* activities ensure that everyone's experience is different, appropriate and *fun*. Our year-round staff, artists and experts are hired to create specialized *learning* moments in a *safe* setting.

All plans are subject to change and may not be listed herein, since many are developed with the children in attendance. The theme for the day sets the tone for the daily offerings and is expressed in a balanced and *organized* schedule that includes physical and creative outlets, *teamwork*, and outdoor *fun*.

Everyday Activities for all ages:

Campers have morning and afternoon meetings to review the day's activity schedule and make adjustment Planned activities are based on camper's age and adjusted according to the groups' interest. Daily schedule includes time in classrooms, art room cook/eat in our kitchenette, play in our gymnasium or playground outdoors. We have our own GAGA PIT and 9 SQUARE.

Oldest Campers: Ages 8 plus This age group rather spend their school vacation hanging out with new and old friends and participate in activities that interest them. For this reason, we are setting up activities in one area as stations and campers can move around to participate in activities of interest. **Gaga Ball, 9square and spike ball will be part of the daily schedule**

What to bring:

Campers are required to wear sneakers and rain gear in case of incitement weather. Campers must bring lunch (no glass bottles) & water bottles. Must wear sneakers to participate in gym and playground activities.

Vacation Camp Themes:

Thursday, June 4th: Central Park Meer Catch & Release Fishing

The Harlem Meer is a thriving aquatic ecosystem that supports a wide variety of fish, waterfowl, turtles, plants and microorganisms. Campers participate in a "Catch & Release" fishing program before lunch and then head out to bird watch with help from staff from the Dana Discovery Center. How many unique birds can we spot? Along the way, campers climb rock sides and jog on the jogging trail.

Tuesday, June 9th: Morningside Park Adventure

Morningside Park is ours as campers choose clubs offered at the Park and A.C.T. Enjoy a game of softball and kickball on the open field. Activity options include sitting under trees while making lanyard crafts or friendship bracelets. Lunch by the waterfall near the jungle gym area offers a relaxing treat.
