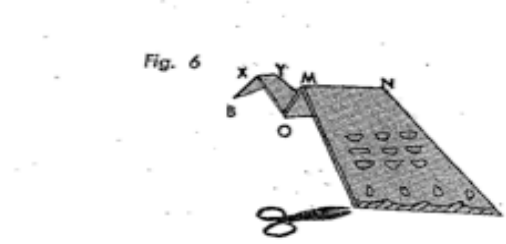
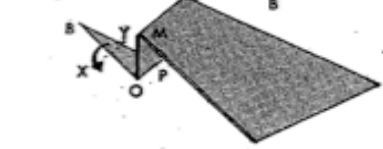
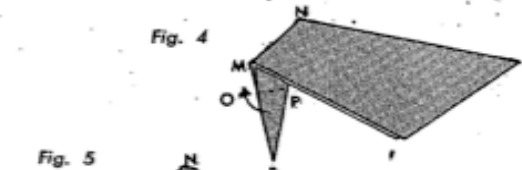
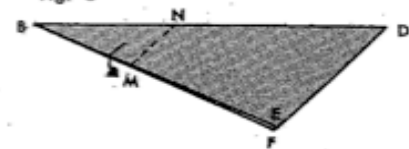
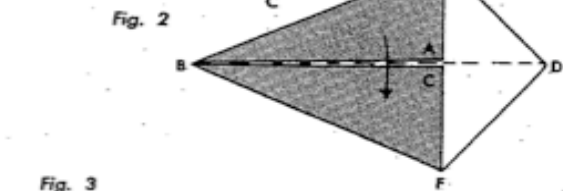
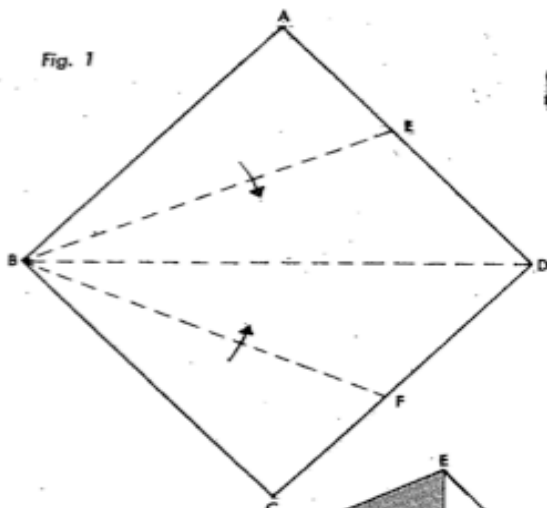


Origami Instructions

Peacock



1. Fold a square piece of paper along lines BE and BF (Fig. 1) so that edges BA and BC meet at the center BD (Fig. 2).

2. Fold along BD (Fig. 2) so that E falls on F (Fig. 3).

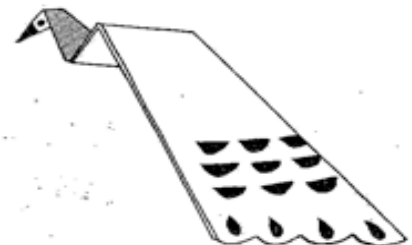
3. Fold back point B along MN (Figs. 3 & 4).

4. Fold along OP, bringing point B back and upward (Figs. 4 & 5).

5. Make the head by folding along XY, turning point B back and downward to the left (Fig. 5).

6. Draw the feathers and cut their ends (Fig. 6).

Note: By using two papers of different colors, one placed on top of the other, the feathers can be cut out from the top paper and the other color will show from the inside.



Church

MATERIALS: Folding paper (white 12" x 12")

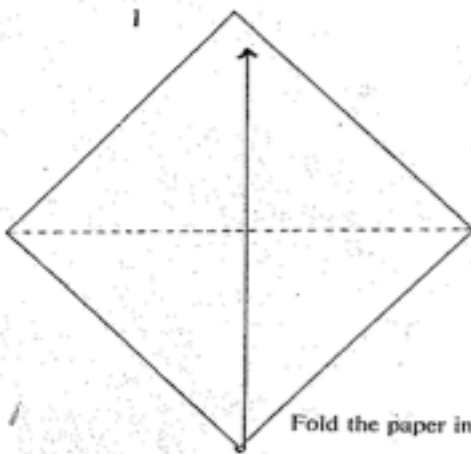
Construction paper:

White (12" x 9")

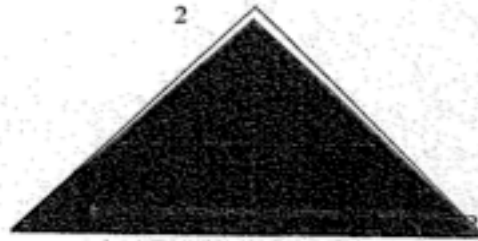
Green (12" x 9")

Brown scraps

Color crayons or water paint, scissors, and paste



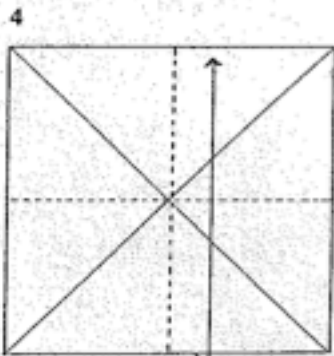
Fold the paper into a triangle.



Fold into a triangle again.



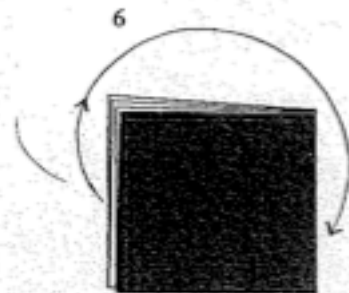
Crease it well.



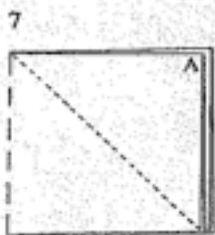
Open the paper so you can see the diagonal lines.



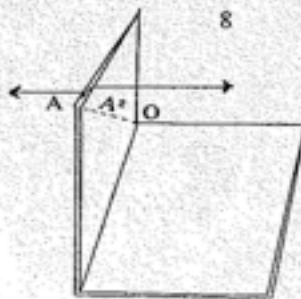
Fold it in half twice.



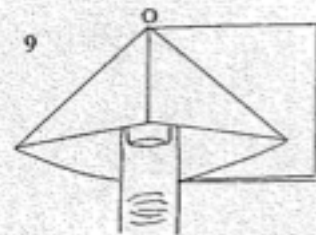
Turn it around.

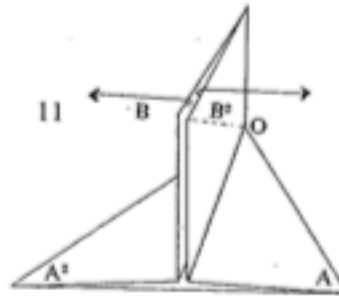
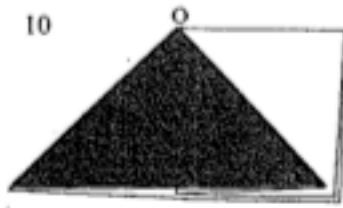


Hold A straight up.



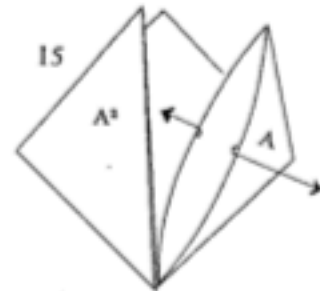
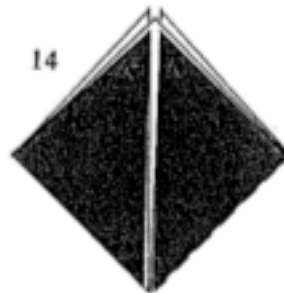
Open A and A* by putting your finger inside to top O. Fold into a triangle.





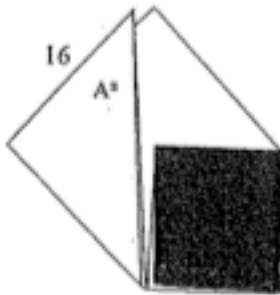
Turn over and repeat, holding the corner up straight and then opening into a triangle.

Bring points B and B² to the top O.

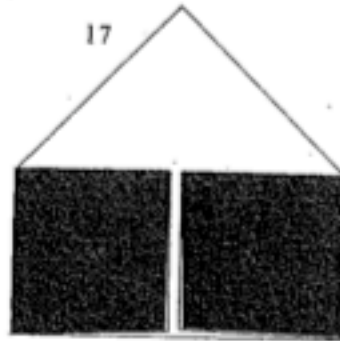


Turn over and repeat with A and A².

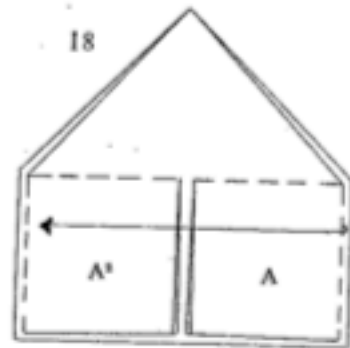
Pull side A out.



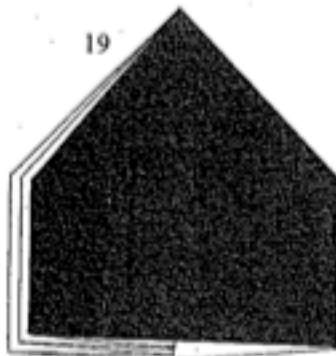
Press down into a square.



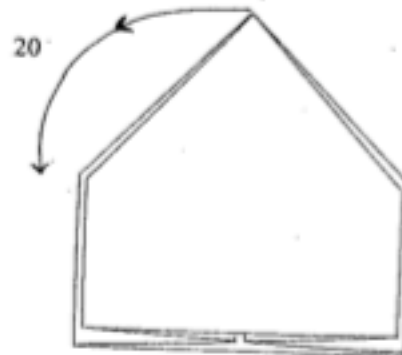
Repeat with side A². Turn over and repeat with the other two points.



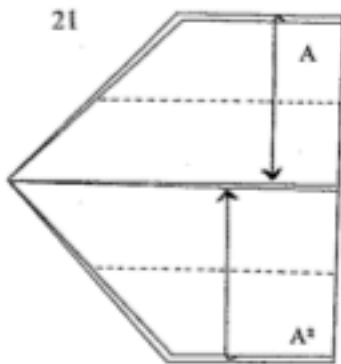
Bring side A over to side A².



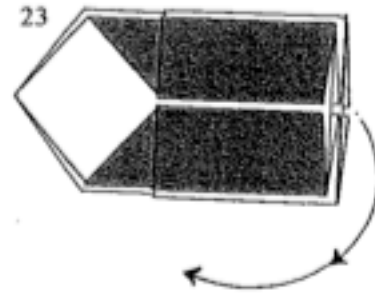
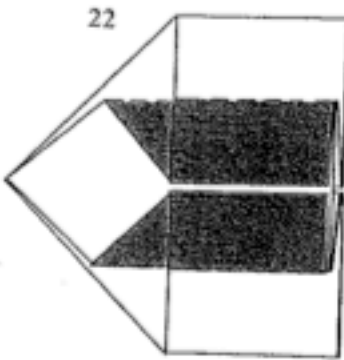
Turn over and repeat on the other side.



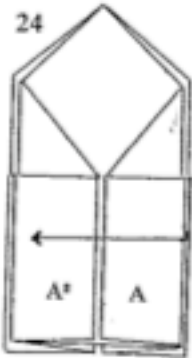
Turn the paper on its side.



Bring sides A and A² to the creased line in the center.
Turn over and repeat on the other side.



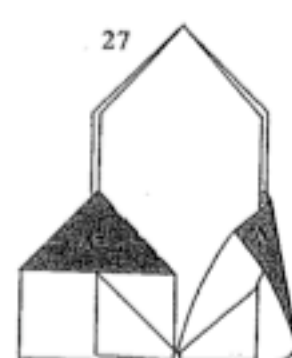
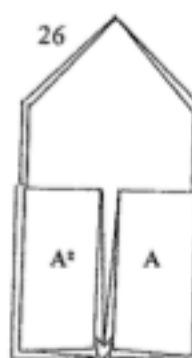
Turn the paper around.



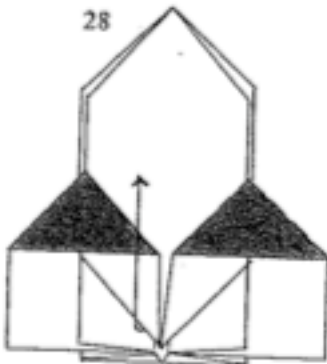
Bring side A over to side A².



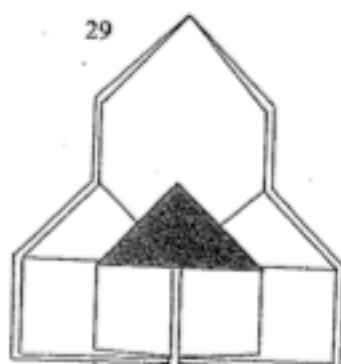
Turn over and repeat.



Open side A² and press it down flat to form the roof shape. Repeat with side A.



Bring the triangle which points to the center of the bottom up and fold it back.



Turn over and repeat. Draw the doors, windows, and bell. Cut a cross and paste it on the top.



Cut out two trees. Slit one halfway down. Slit the other halfway up.

Fit the two trees together.

*The church stands up by itself, so if you make two Christmas trees with green construction paper that stand and use them on either side of the church, it will look more attractive.
