The Cathedral Church of Saint John the Divine to Host Palm Sunday Holy Eucharist Service at the Start of Holy Week in NYC

On Sunday, March 24, 2024 at 10:30 am, the largest Gothic Cathedral in the world and Episcopal church will host a procession of blessed palm leaves on one of the holiest days of the year for Christians

WHO: The Very Rev. Patrick Malloy, PhD, the Dean of the Cathedral; The Rev. Canon Eva Suarez,

Canon for Community Engagement of the Cathedral; and others.

WHAT: Kicking off Holy Week in New York City, The Cathedral Church of Saint John the Divine will

host its Annual Palm Sunday Holy Eucharist service, welcoming the local community, New

Yorkers, and visitors from around the globe.

With the distribution of blessed palm leaves, the service will begin outside the Cathedral and process into the Nave. Note: The Cathedral's Palm Sunday worship service will be held in-person, as well as livestreamed on the Cathedral's website.

As one of the holiest days in the year for Christians, Palm Sunday falls on the last Sunday of Lent and the first day of Holy Week, commemorating when Christ entered the city of Jerusalem to face crucifixion before being resurrected. For many observing Christians, Palm Sunday is a time to reflect and honor Jesus's sacrifice throughout Holy Week leading up to Easter.

On Easter Sunday, March 31, 2024, the Cathedral will also host its Annual Easter Day Service from 10:30 am to 12:30 pm. Holy Week services will be seated in a first come first serve basis. We ask those who would like to attend on Easter Sunday to RSVP so we have a sense of how many people will be joining us, but passes are not required to any of these services.
